RESOLUTION 2023-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF DUTCH JOHN APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE LEGAL SERVICES UNDER THE TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, the parties are authorized by the Utah Interlocal Cooperation Act, as set forth in Title 11, Chapter 13, Utah Code Ann. to enter into agreements with other public agencies on the basis of mutual advantage and to more efficiently provide services to the general public; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish and adopt an Interlocal Agreement to share legal services under the terms and provisions of this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, The Town Council of the Town of Dutch John

has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the Town's residents to approve this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, obligations, and/or covenants contained here, and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt, fairness, and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

SECTION 1. Interlocal Agreement. The Town Council of the Town of Dutch John desires to enter into this joint cooperation agreement.

SECTION 2. Approval. The Town Council of the Town of Dutch John hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute the Interlocal Agreement to share legal services on behalf of the Town of Dutch John when finalized and approved by Town Council.


SECTION 3. Severability. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable and if any provision thereof or the application of such provision under any circumstances is held invalid, it shall not affect any other provision of this resolution or the application in a different circumstance.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the governing or legislative bodies of each agency.
