Dutch John Court House (Old Post Office), 555 S. Center St., Dutch John, UT 84023, Serial Number DJ-01-02

Ten acre parcel to the South of South Blvd, between the airport road and Bureau of Reclamation property, Serial Number 405-1

Dutch John Memorial Park/Dutch John Cemetery, 515 N. Elk Ridge Parkway, Dutch John, UT 84023, Serial Number 418

The Big Lawn located on 5th Avenue between S. Blvd. and N. Center St., Serial Number DJ-02-10
