INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

The Town of Dutch John invites qualified, experienced, licensed fireworks professionals to submit a proposal to prepare and execute an aerial fireworks show for the Dutch John Freedom Festival. This is an annual event.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Contractor will provide a minimum 25-minute fireworks display on the dates and times listed above and will be responsible for set-up, permitting, cleanup and coordination with public safety departments.

COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

The contractor must hold a current Utah Pyrotechnic Operator License and comply with Utah Fire Prevention Code, NFPA 1123. Each employee will need a BATFE (Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosive) letter showing completion of training.

INSURANCE

Liability insurance minimum \$4,000,000 required, naming the Town of Dutch John and a designated property owner if necessary as additional insured parties.

FEE PROPOSAL

Submit a detailed cost proposal.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Evaluation will consider compliance, experience, quality, creativity, price and references. The Town of Dutch John reserves all rights to reject or negotiate proposals.


