

## NOTICE OF ELECTION 2025

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, 10-3-301:

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that there will be a municipal general election on November 4, 2025 for the following offices:

Two at-large Town Council positions (4-year term)

The constitutional and statutory qualification requirements for municipal office are:

- 1. Be a United States citizen at the time of filing.
- 2. Be a registered voter in Daggett County Dutch John Precinct #1
- 3. Be at least 18 years old at the time of the next election
- 4. Be a legal resident of the Town of Dutch John for twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election.
  - 5. Not be a convicted felon, unless the right to vote or hold office has been restored.

You must declare your candidacy in person with the Town Clerk (Harriet Dickerson) between June 1 and June 7, excluding Saturday and Sunday.

The law requires availability during regular business hours. (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) Since we do not have these regular business hours, Harriet Dickerson, or her designee, will be available at 103 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave., between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m, Monday June 2 thru Friday June 6, 2025.

No filings will be accepted after that time.
